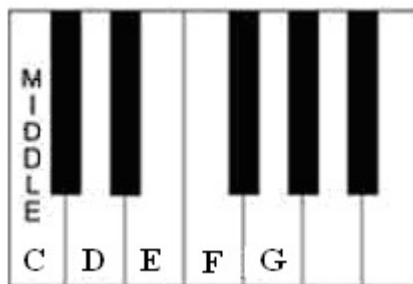


With a little help from my friends- Beatles

E: 3 – 4 – 5 – 5 __, 4 – 3 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 4 __,
What would you do if I sang out of tune,

F: 4 – 4 – 3 – 2 – 2 – 2 – 1 – 2 – 3 __,
Would you stand up and walk out on me,

E: 3 – 4 – 5 – 5 __, 4 – 3 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 4 __,
Lend me your ears, and I'll sing you a song,

F: 4 – 4 – 3 – 2 – 2 – 2 – 1 – 2 – 3 __,
And I'll try not to sing out of key.

G: 5 – 1 – 3 – 2 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 __,
Oh I get by with a lit - tle help from my friends,

G: 5 – 1 – 3 – 2 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 __,
Oh I get high with a lit - tle help from my friends

G: 5 – 1 – 2 – 3 – 2 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 – 1 __,
Oh I'm gon - na try with a lit - tle help from my friends,

This sign: _ Indicates tone length (The longer the line is, the longer you should wait).

This sign: , indicates the ending of a musical phrase.

**Instructions: first – listen to the midi file a couple of times, then place your hand position on the keyboard as stated above. This will guarantee your success with playing the song by ear easily.*

Now that you succeeded playing the song by ear in the original key try to put the third finger (first finger played in the song) on a different key and see if you succeed playing the song from there (The letters above will tell you which key you should start playing with).
For example: If you start with B, you'll be playing: B – C – D – D , etc...
