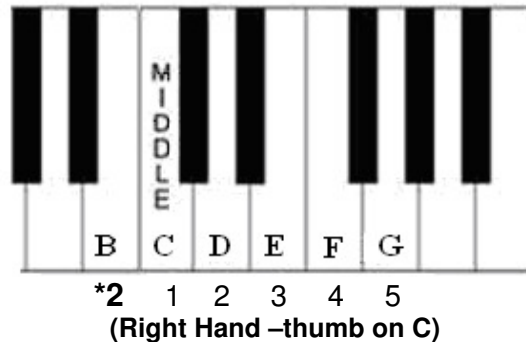


Deck in the halls (Christmas Carol)

the ending of a

*This sign: *2* means
that you should cross
your second finger
over your thumb.

3. Now play the melody at different places on the piano: The letters below will tell you with which key you should start playing - For example: If you start with E- you'll put your fifth finger on E and play: E – D – C# – B – A etc...
