(Right Hand-thumb on D)

G 4 – 5 – 4 – 3 – 2 – 3 – 4 __, Lon-don Bridge is fal-ling down,
D 1 – 2 – 3 __, 2 – 3 – 4 __, Fal - ling down, fall- ing down.
G 4 – 5 – 4 – 3 – 2 – 3 – 4 __, Lon-don Bridge is fal - ling down,
D C 1 __ 4 __ 2 – (*1). My fair la - dy!

This sign: —
Indicates tone length
(The longer the line is,
the longer you should
hold the key down).

*This sign: , indicates
the ending of a
musical phrase*

(*1)-here-the thumb
is pressing C, and not
the D as before.



***Instructions:**

1. Listen to the Audio file a couple of times.
2. Place your hand in the position shown above, and play easily by using the finger numbers.
3. Now play the melody at different places on the piano: The letters below will tell you with which key you should start playing - For example : If you start with E, you'll put your forth finger on E and you'll be playing: E – F# – E – D – C# , etc...
