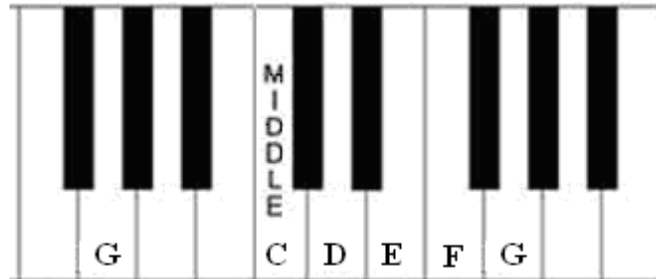


Ode To Joy

3. Now play the melody at different places on the piano: The letters below will tell you with which key you should start playing - For example: If you start with B- you'll put your third finger on B and play: B – B – C – D – D etc...
